HACIENDAS OF THE YUCATÁN

A rich and diverse heritage

The harienth system was the economic backbonn of rural Mexico for handreds of years, reaching its good during the horsequers beam of the lates 10th and early 20th certuries. After the Mexican Revolution of 1910, many hairendas were deserted and left to deeps, Now, Masks to a resuggence of interest in prescring the past, they are being cought on and restored. While hoiseasts vary in appearance depending on when, where and for whom they were built, those in the Yuentin share certain characteristics. Included are a mix of Mayan and Spanish influences, buildings constructed of stacked rability atoms, often sabaged from Mayan rains, upon partials elogiqued to provide shade and invite hercers, and fully rooms with high beamed ceilings and could like floors. Buildings were singlestory, and rooms were arranged in a contingous parties with aliqued decoverys for maximum air criculation.
